V. REPORTS

A. Financial Report

The treasurer presented the bills for payment. The clerk explained that the solid waste bill was two months' worth of charges, because Great American Disposal bills were usually two months behind, whereas the new company (Green for Life Environmental) bills on time and charges late fees, so it had to be paid. She further noted this brought the solid waste account to the edge of its budget.

B. Assessor Report

The assessor was present and gave a verbal report. The change of assessment notices were mailed and the roll is being prepared. There were few changes – land values went up slightly, but improvement values increased significantly due to sale prices for homes being high. Taxable values are capped (at 5%), however, and will not increase as significantly (3.3%). The Board of Review may be busy due to this (scheduled for March 15 & 16).

C. Zoning Administrator Report

The clerk read the report from the zoning administrator (copy on file), which covered two approvals of zoning applications for a lot on FFR 2520 (off Rock River Road) and one on Deerton-Sand Lake Road; and several questions about operating vacation rentals and campgrounds in zoning districts other than Town Development.

D. Fire Department Report

Chief Kimar read the Fire Department Report (copy on file). The chief plans to write a letter of complaint to Ferrellgas, since the firehall ran out of propane on 2/25 at 11 pm and an emergency fill of the tank was required, despite the fact that it is on the "keep-full" program, which mis-estimated the tank being at 40% when it was empty.

E. Planning Commission Report

Trustee Bresette reported that Central UP Planning and Development (CUPPAD) is sending surveys and waiting 30 days to check for return of the survey – if return rates are low at this time, they will wait an additional 15 days for further returns.

F. Supervisor Report

The supervisor reported on the following:

- * Attended Regional Government meeting most local townships and cities plan to use the funds for infrastructure improvements.
- * Talked to new company (GFLE) now operating garbage pickup there is no more holiday delay on pickups.
- * Wrote a letter to Au Train-Onota Schools commending them for their students exceptional performance in the Science Olympiad competition.
- * Generators were serviced this past Friday.

G. Tyoga Update

Waiting for Dept of Natural Resources to finalize contract and paperwork for this year's operations. New members are joining the Friends of Tyoga group and interested in participating in the spring trail cleanup day that will be held once the snow melts.

H. Other Reports

Trustee Lacko reported several residents are interested in using the hall for a combination craft and/or rummage sale. She checked with Michigan Township Association and they saw no issue with this. The board had no objections to this use. She plans to organize this event once the weather improves.
